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Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 1 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. 2

The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other 3 persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation 5 Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and the Chairman 6 7 of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited appearance 8 will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine witnesses. 9

10 This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No 11 substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the 12 Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC 13 pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on 14 15 these matters before the ACC must be a party to the proceeding before the Committee.
