SRP is proud to support the diverse communities where we live and work. In 2023, we gave more than \$4.7 million to over 300 nonprofit organizations across the state.

Safety Signature Program

SRP's safety campaign, Safe.Strong.SRP., helps keep families and children safe around water and electricity by providing vital information online, at community events and through workshops.

INCREASING WATER AND ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- 250,000 people reached annually
- 364 life jackets and 1,717 swim lessons donated to community pools each summer
- 16 pool fences donated and installed in 2023
- Annual Electrical Safety Workshop provides training on the safest ways to work around power lines
